






About Martin County, NC

Martin County was established on March 14, 1774. It was named for Josiah Martin, the last royal governor of NC (1771-1775). The county is approximately 461 square miles in area and as of the 2010 census the population was 24,505 persons. The county seat is Williamston. The Roanoke River runs along the boundary of the north side of the county.

There are a variety of ways to have fun in Martin County, from camping and fishing to shopping, eating and enjoying the county's rich historic sites. For those craving adventure, there is the opportunity to see a car race or even go skydiving!







Map guide to the cultural, dining and recreation sites in Martin County.





