

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF

November 17, 2020

The Board of Commissioners of the Town of Williamston met in special session on Thursday, November 17, 2020 at 9:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at Town Hall, Williamston, NC.

CALL TO ORDER AND INVOCATION

The Mayor called the meeting to order and requested the Town Clerk to do a roll call of Board members. Commissioner Rodgers led the pledge of allegiance. Commissioner Knox offered the invocation.

AGENDA APPROVED

The Mayor requested a motion to approve the agenda as presented. *It was moved by Commissioner Rodgers, seconded by Commissioner Knox, and unanimously passed via roll call to approve the regular agenda as presented.*

Approval of Martin Luther King Drive Project Change

The Town Administrator reported the contractor has begun the street project on Martin Luther King Drive. When the asphalt was removed, it was found the base was clay close to the cemetery area and would need a bed of rock prior to pouring asphalt. The rock was quoted at \$25,799.18. Commissioner Rodgers reported visiting the site and spoke with a supervisor. He was informed the road would be bad in a couple of years if a rock bed was not in place. The Public Works Director reported some of the soil will need to be removed and replaced with stone. Commissioner Coffield questioned if the funds were available. The Town Administrator reported there were funds in the Powell Bill Fund. Commissioner Moore reported the need is there and we need to do what it takes to *It was moved by Commissioner Knox, seconded by Commissioner Coffield, and unanimously passed via roll call to approve the additional expenditure of \$25,799.18 to install a rock bed on Martin Luther King Drive as requested.*

There being no further business, the Mayor declared the meeting adjourned at 9:14 p.m.
