2. Submit to Treasury a Citizen's Guide, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report.

This certification, along with a Citizen's Guide, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report, **must be received by December 1, 2014** (or the first day of a payment month) in order to qualify for that month's payment. 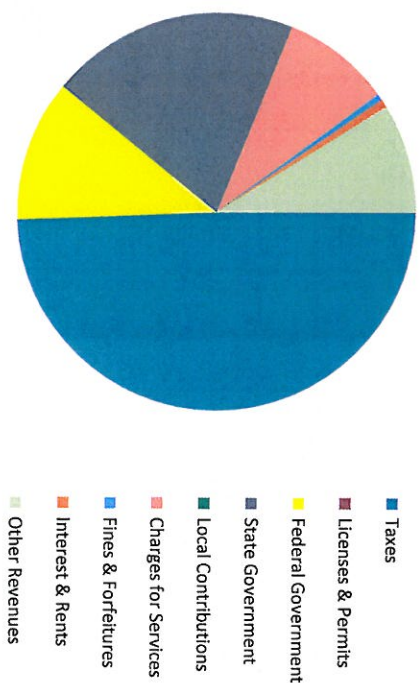

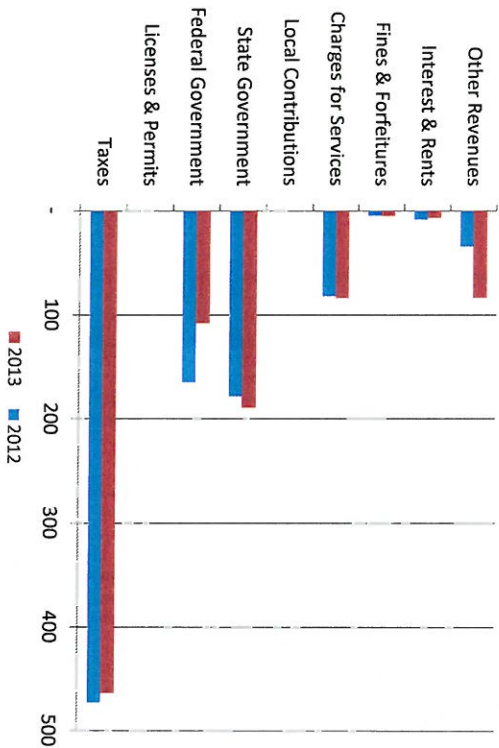

3. Revenue sources per capita - compared to the prior year



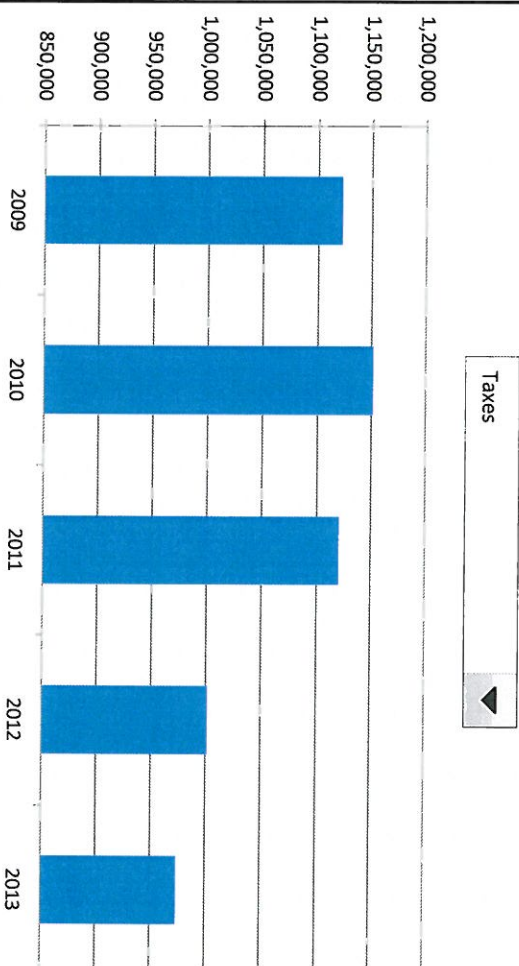

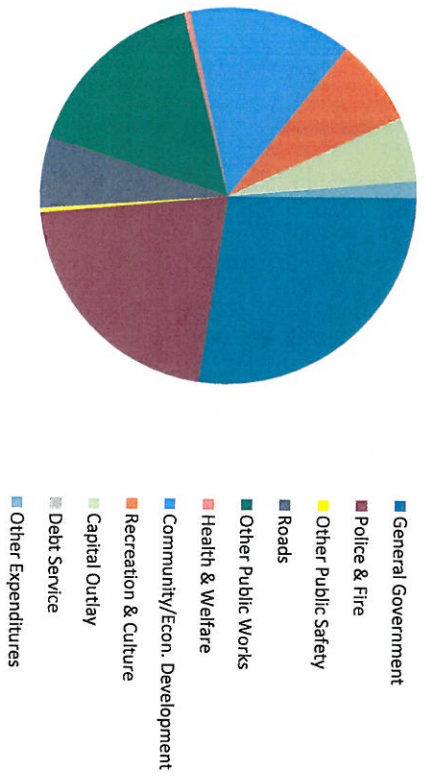

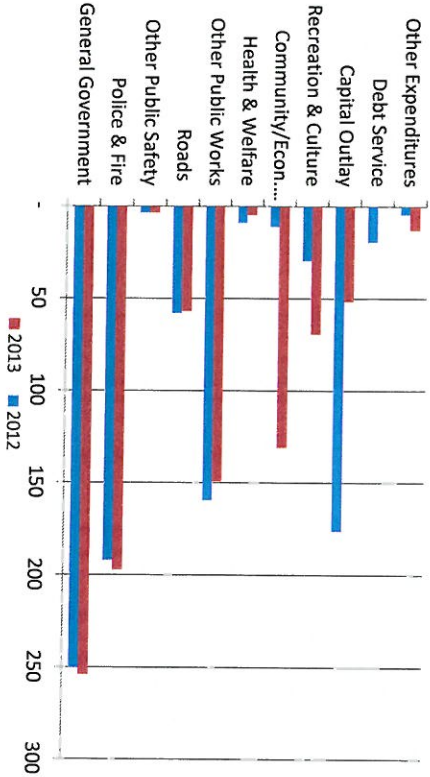


1. Where we spend our money (all governmental funds)

3. Spending per capita - compared to the prior year



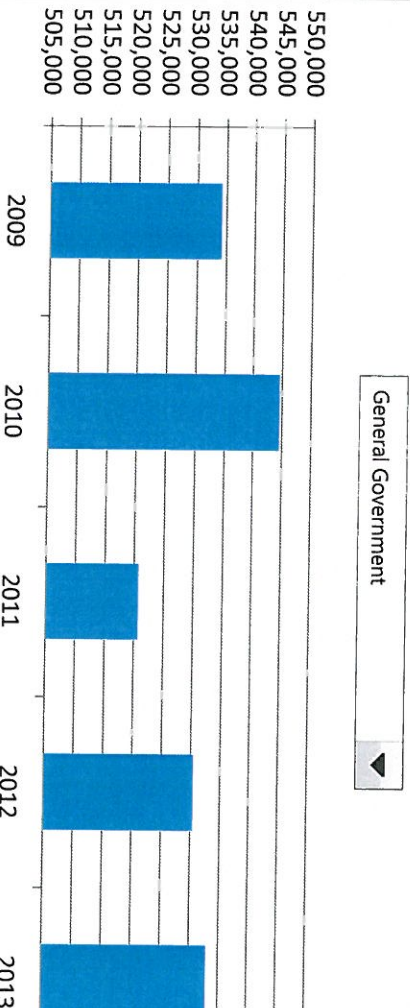

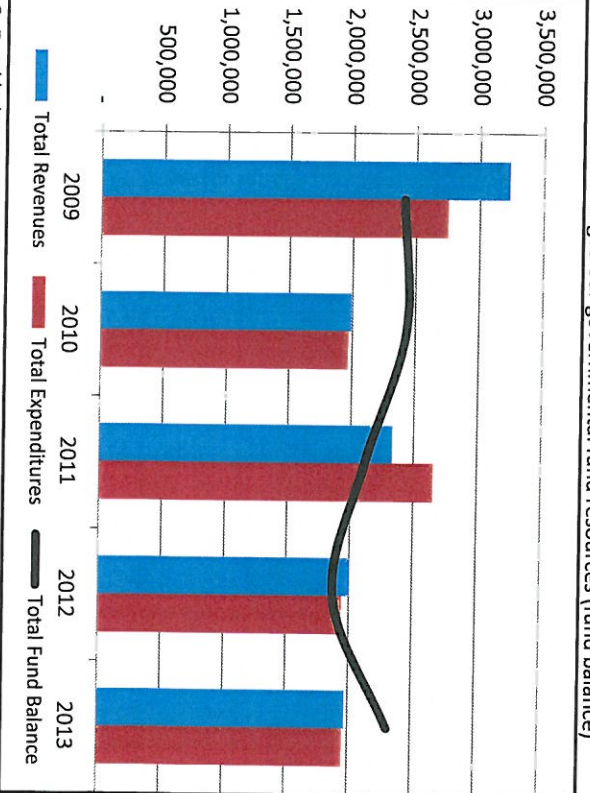

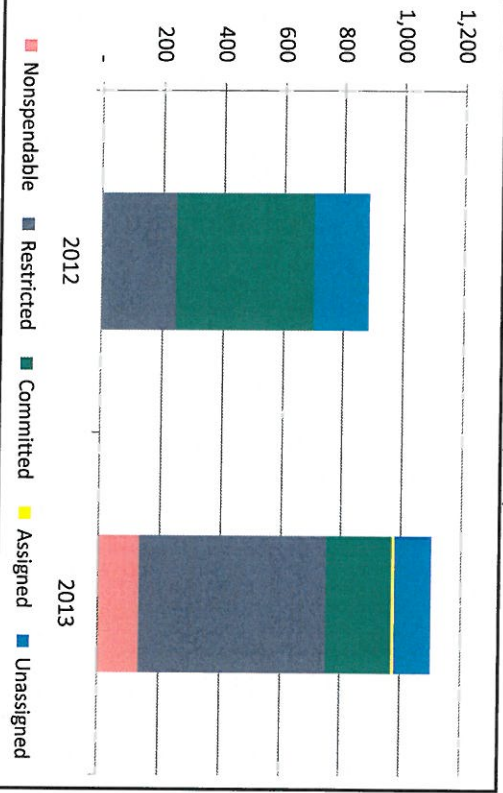

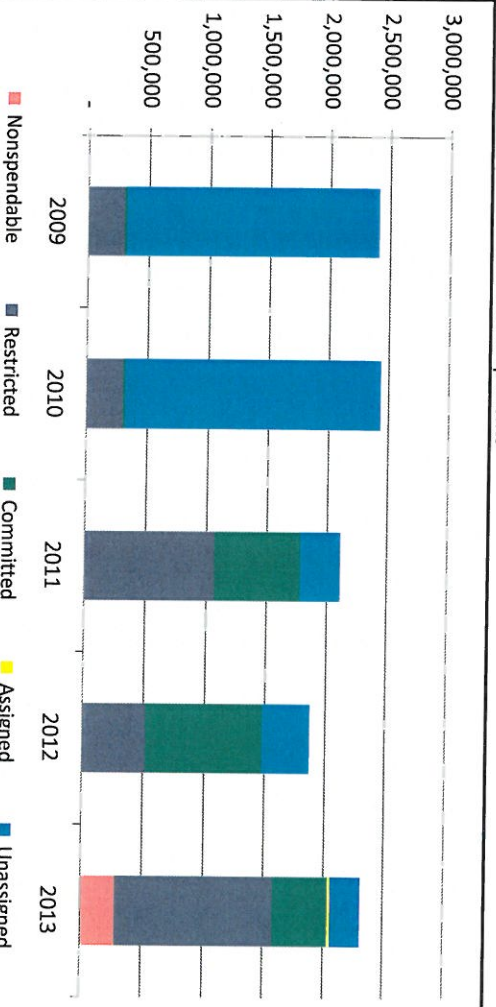

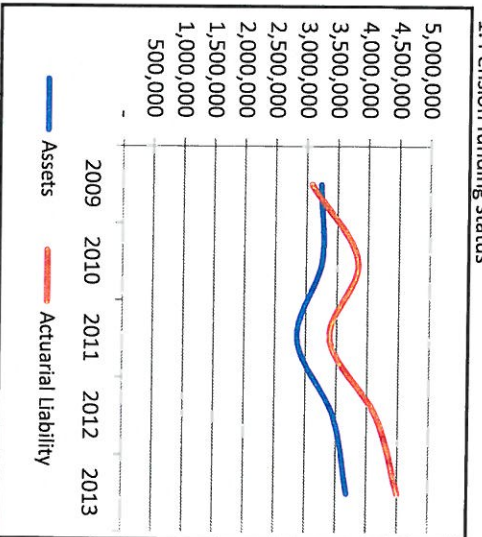

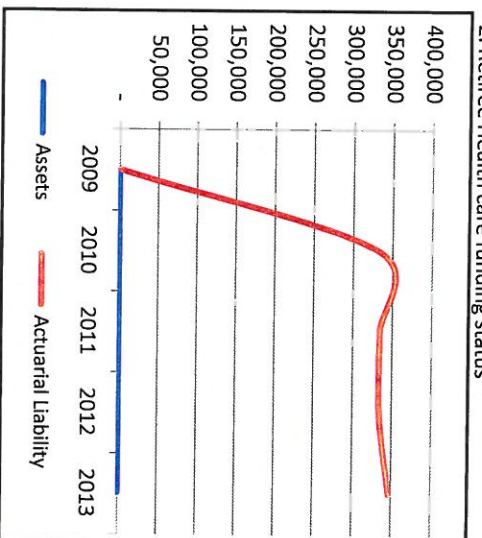

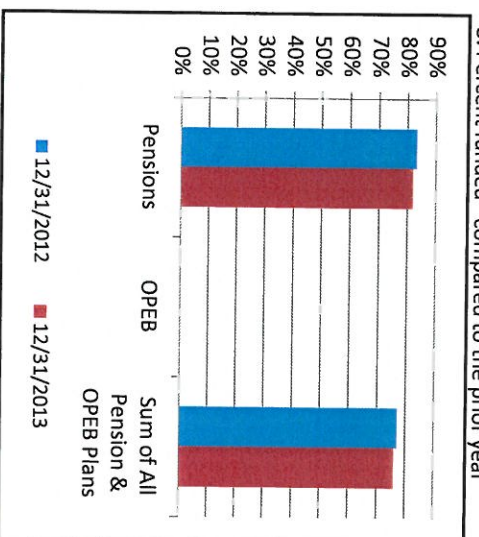
1. Pension funding status



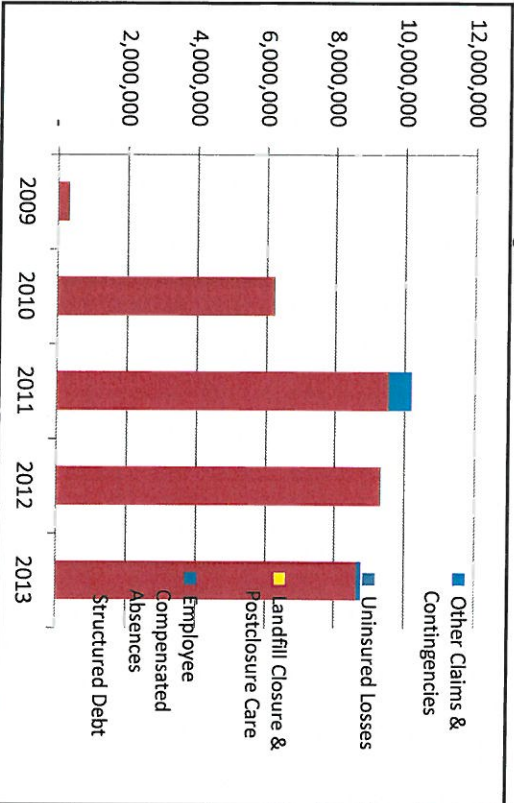
2. Retiree Health care funding status



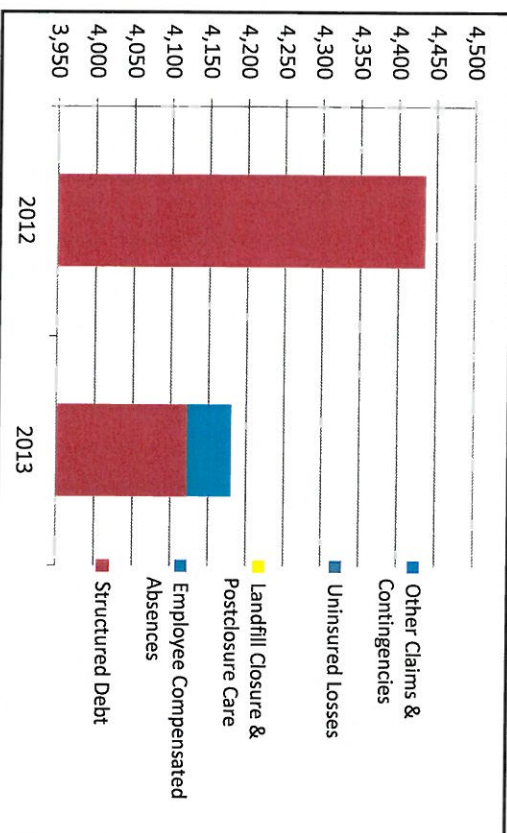
3. Percent funded - compared to the prior year
