- 2. Submit to Treasury a Citizen's Guide, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report.

This certification, along with a Citizen's Guide, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report, **must** be received by December 1, 2014 (or the first day of a payment month) in order to qualify for that month's payment. 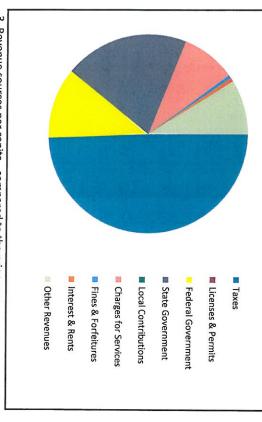

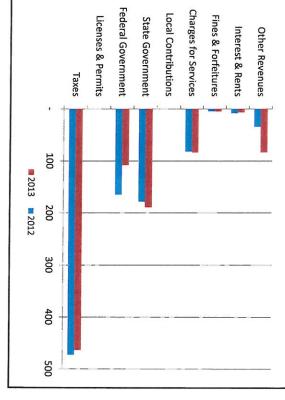

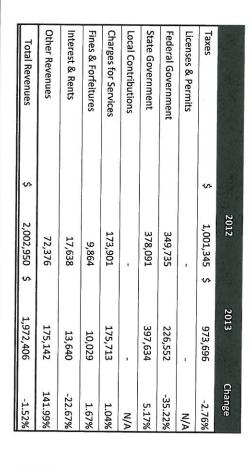
1. Where our money comes from (all governmental funds)

1. How have we managed our governmental fund resources (fund balance)

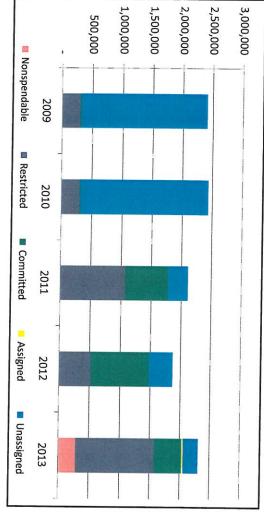
