Acceptable material guidelines

- Cardboard, paper bags (*flattened & cut into pieces, no wax coated cardboard*)
- Paperboard (*cereal boxes, no wax coated paperboard*)
- Magazines, catalogs
- Junk mail (*envelopes, flyers, brochures, postcards, etc*)
- Office paper
- Phone books
- Newspaper (*remove bags, strings & rubber bands*)
- Pots & pans
- Steel & tin cans (*please rinse/clean cans before recycling*)
- Clear glass only (*please rinse/clean glass before recycling*)
- Aluminum cans (*please rinse/clean cans before recycling*)
- Plastic jugs/bottles, household plastics (*#s 1 - 7, please rinse/clean before recycling*)

- GPS units
- iPods, MP3 players
- Ink and toner cartridges
- Microwaves
- Medical equipment (*non-hazardous*)
- Power tools (*electric only*)
- Projectors
- Radios, stereos and CD players
- Telephone systems, answering machines
- Televisions
- Various media (*floppy disks, CDs, DVDs, memory sticks*)

Computer components and accessories

- Circuit boards
- Computers (*Desktops, Laptops, Main Frames, Tablets*)
- Docking stations, routers
- Hard Drives
- Internal, external disk drives
- Keyboards and mice
- Modems
- Monitors (*any size*)
- Networking equipment
- PDAs (*Blackberrys, Palm Pilots, iPhones*)
- Power cords, cables, wires
- Printers, scanners
- Ram/Memory
- Servers, server racks
- Speakers
- Tape back-ups
- UPS Battery back-ups

Office and household electron/cs

- Air cleaners, humidifiers
- Cellular telephones

Other unacceptable items: paper milk or juice cartons, Styrofoam, garbage, propane tanks, paint cans, colored glass, medical waste, flammable liquids, household cleaners, chemicals (liquid or dry) and wood items, plastic bags, hangers (metal and plastic)
