City Manager advised Council that there was a possibility that the main meter would be back working for the event. Also that Caddo County assumed that the meters would be read before and after the event.

McGlothlin- advised that in the past that the Expo would pay a deposit and then the City would bill accordingly, either with billing or a refund if usage was less than the deposit.

Motion made by McBride to get readings before and after the event and to table to the 14<sup>th</sup> Council meeting. Seconded by Redbird.


