

AMENDMENT to Article VI, Section 635, Central Commercial District (C-1)


BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Barnesville, and it is hereby enacted by authority of same an amendment to the Official Zoning Ordinance of the City of Barnesville as follows:


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BARNESVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE Article VI, Section 635, Central Commercial District (C-1), Subsection 635.2 Permitted Uses, to add Sub-Subsection (rr) Pet Grooming Facilities as a Permitted Use with the following regulations:


- 1- Each Facility is limited to no more than 3 pets on the premises at any given time.
- 2- No boarding or keeping of pets permitted. Pet visits are limited to the normal and customary time required to provide the grooming service.
- 3- Pets are not allowed to be left unattended inside or outside the facility.
- 4- City streets, rights of way, and landscaped areas are not permitted to be used for pet's bodily functions. Business patrons and/or business owners are responsible for cleanup.
- 5- Pets must be transported to and from the facility in a pet carrier or on a leash and collar.
- 6- For the purposes of this code section "Pet" is defined as a household animal kept for companionship and a person's enjoyment, as opposed to livestock, laboratory animals, and working animals.




