ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF GUESTS

Mr. Shawn Anderson, with the Tipton County GIS, made a presentation on how the Town of Brighton participates in Geographic Information System mapping technology. The Town of Brighton accepted the program in 2008. As of today, the Town of Brighton currently has two copies of the software. One copy is with Kinney Bridges, Town of Brighton Fire Chief and the other copy is with Mr. Matalee Hall, Town of Brighton Public Works Director. The pictometry program which is separate from GIS is used by Kinney Bridges. This program is used to measure, analyze and even visualize. GIS information is updated daily. It includes information such as utility lines, flood, bridges, property lines etc.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Fire Department: Fire Chief Kinney Bridges presented the monthly status report (see attached report). As of July 6, 2015, there has been \$25,820.00 in fire subscriptions collected.

Police Department: Police Chief Mike Durham presented the monthly status report (see attached report).

Public Works: Director Hall presented the monthly status report (see attached report). Water sampling is being done this week at 20 different locations. It needs to be completed during the hottest annual temperatures.

B & C Construction has started the repair work based on their bid proposals.

The Town of Brighton has received reimbursement from State Farm for the damage to our lift station earlier this year. Their client ran off the road damaging our lift station. The reimbursement totaled \$10,926.00.
