NEW BUSINESS

FYE 18/19 BUDGET AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

The FYE 18/19 Budget Amendment Ordinance was presented. **Alderwoman Chapman-Washam made a motion to approve the Second Reading of the FYE 18/19 Budget Amendment Ordinance. Aldew0man Greer seconded the motion. All approved Motion passed.**

FY 19/20 BUDGET ORDINANCE

The FY 19/20 Budget Ordinance was presented. **Alderman Chapman-Washam made a motion to approve the Second Reading of the FY 19/20 Budget Ordinance. Alderman Greer seconded the motion.**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen discussed some of the line items.

Alderwoman Chapman-Washam noticed that in the FYE 18/19 estimated budget it showed a total of \$3,000 bonus paid to the firemen instead of a total of \$4,000 because there are 4 full time firemen. Ms. McKinney pulled the payroll report for that week and noticed a particular fireman's bonus was miscoded out of salaries instead of bonus. Ms. McKinney will correct that error.

Aldermen Greer attended the Elected Officials II meeting over the weekend. They spoke about towns planning for their future for things such as fire trucks, police cars, road maintenance, etc. Towns need to start preparing for these costs ahead of time instead of getting hit all at once. Ms. McKinney stated that she remembered speaking of this before. If you set aside \$50,000.00 for a fire truck. That money is designated for that purpose. You can't spend it for any other reason. Aldermen Greer asked if that would be a good thing to do especially for the road maintenance because it seems to be so expensive.

Alderman Greer questioned the \$14,000 allocated to the Parks Supply line item. Mayor Crocker can't remember why that was so high. She asked for it to be reduced to \$4,000.

Departmental raises were discussed. Each department was allotted a different dollar amount for raises.

Alderman Greer, Alderman Hall, Alderman Smith all approved the budget after adjustments are made to the budget. Motion passed.

ADJOURNMENT

Alderman Greer made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hall. Alderman Greer, Alderman Hall and Alderman Smith approved. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:00p.m.
