

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S SECTION 23--SAFER ROADS DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town of Brighton has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of said Town to enter into a contract and agreement in accordance with Section 23, Title 23, United States Code Annotated and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of Transportation for the installation of traffic control signs, and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Brighton have determined that the above referenced agreement will greatly assist in the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of said Town, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project contemplated by the agreement is in such amount that it will not adversely affect the financial condition of the Town to any substantial extent,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Brighton, Tennessee, that:

SECTION I

The Mayor of the Town of Brighton is hereby authorized to execute the State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation, Section 230 - Safer Roads Demonstration Program Agreement (a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A") and is hereby authorized to sign said agreement for the Town of Brighton and to obligate the Town of Brighton thereunder.

SECTION II

That all ordinances of a general and permanent nature in contradiction herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it, and shall be effective on and after that date.
