The owners or occupants of such premises have also signed agreements that no unauthorized or unapproved installations will be permitted.

To the best of our knowledge and belief, there are no unapproved or unauthorized cross connections, auxiliary intakes, bypasses or interconnections which may affect the quality of the public water supply.
