

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON BY THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY ADJOINING ITS EXISTING BOUNDARIES:

Whereas, a petition signed by a majority of the residents and property owners of the affected area has been filed with the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brighton requesting that the corporate limits of the Town of Brighton be extended by the annexation of the territory adjoining its existing boundaries hereinafter described by metes and bounds; and after notice as required by law, a public hearing has been had upon the advisability of the annexation of such territory, and the Board has determined that the annexation of the same is necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the affected territory, as well as the municipality as a whole, and that the prosperity of the municipality and such territory will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and the property thereof endangered unless the corporate limits of the municipality be so extended: Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, at a called meeting of said Mayor and Council:


SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the Town of Brighton be and they are hereby extended so as to include therein the following territory adjoining its existing boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at a 24 inch sweetgum in the west line of the present corporate limits, the same being approximately 100 feet northeast of the Ollie Alston house as described on the present line; thence south 64° west 1470 feet to an iron stake northwest of a tenant house belonging to C. N. Turner; thence south 16° west 2509 feet to an iron stake in the fence line of Ed Calhoun's lot north-west of barn, said line crossing the Brighton to Beaver gravel road at 270 feet; thence south 6½° east (passing through a power pole at 673 feet) a total distance of 720 feet to a stake in the field, 57 feet south of said

power pole; thence south 82 3/4° east 1522 feet to a stake in the east line of the Tipton County Penal Farm fence, the same being 50 feet south from the center of the present gravel road, the above line passing an iron stake on the east side of a road at 118 feet at 280 feet passing 60 feet south of Joe Jones' house at 1075 feet passing 106 feet south of the center colored school; thence south 1/4° west 1283 feet to the center of U. S. Highway 51, said point in the original line.

SECTION 1: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as provided by statute, this ordinance shall become operative and said territory included within the corporate limits of the municipality thirty (30) days after this date.
