

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS,
HIGHWAYS AND ALLEYS OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON,
TENNESSEE, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Brighton, Tennessee, that hereafter it shall be unlawful to operate any motor driven vehicle on the highways, streets, roads and alleys of the Town of Brighton, Tennessee, at a speed in excess of twenty-five ³⁰ ~~(25)~~ miles per hour.

SECTION II. Be it further ordained that the Mayor and Council shall be authorized to designate certain streets, highways and alleys of said Town of Brighton as through streets or thoroughfares. Such streets, when so designated as through streets, shall be plainly marked by appropriate signs at every intersection directing all traffic to stop before entering such designated street or thoroughfare. Failure to obey such signs shall be a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION III. Be it further ordained that the Mayor and Town Council may designate certain areas on certain streets as restricted speed zones and such areas on such streets when so designated as restricted speed zones shall be plainly marked within such area by appropriate signs designating the maximum speed for such areas, and it shall be a violation of this ordinance to exceed such designated speed within such areas.

SECTION IV. Be it further ordained that all offenses designated as reckless driving under the traffic code of the State of Tennessee committed within the corporate limits of the Town of Brighton, Tennessee, shall constitute a violation of this ordinance and shall be punishable as hereinafter set out.

SECTION V. Be it further ordained that hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor driven vehicle on the streets, highways, roads and alleys of the town of Brighton without having first obtained from the State of Tennessee a driver's license and to have such license in his possession at the time of the operation of such vehicle.

SECTION VI. Be it further ordained that all violations of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and punishable by fine of not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$50.00.

SECTION VII. Be it further ordained that this ordinance take effect on and after its passage, the welfare of the Town of Brighton requiring it.
