

ORDINANCE NUMBER 011006-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 CHAPTER 1 SECTION 11-106 OF THE BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE TO CONNECTION CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the cost of providing water service is becoming more expensive to the Town of Brighton; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen wish to collect a more equitable fee for connecting to the water system;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, THAT:

Section 1. Title 11, Chapter 1, Section 11-106 of the Brighton Municipal Code is amended by deleting the current language in its entirety and substituting instead the following:


11-106. Connection charges. Service lines will be laid by the town from its mains to the property line at the expense of the applicant for service. The location of such lines will be determined by the town. Before a new water service line will be laid by the Town, the applicant shall pay a nonrefundable connection charge of \$500.00 within the city limits and \$750.00 outside the city limits.

When a service line is completed, the Town shall be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of such service line from the main to and including the meter and meter box, and such portion of the service line shall belong to the city. The remaining portion of the service line beyond the meter box shall belong to and be the responsibility of the customer.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon it's final reading, the public health, safety and welfare requiring it.
