

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 6,
CHAPTER 2, PRIVILEGE TAXES**

WHEREAS, The Town of Brighton, in order to comply with the Laws of the State of Tennessee in regards to Municipal Business Tax, and

WHEREAS, The Brighton Municipal Code, Section 6, Chapter 2, levies the taxes applicable to business,

THEREFORE, The Town of Brighton Board of Mayor and Alderman

HEREBY, enacts the following, with an effective date of **June 1, 2008:**

The Town of Brighton Municipal Code, Section 6, Chapter 2, is hereby amended by removing §201 and §202 and replacing them with the following:

6-201. Tax levied. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this code, there is hereby levied on all vocations, occupations, and businesses declared by the general laws of the state to be privileges taxable by municipalities, an annual privilege tax in the maximum amount allowed by state laws. The taxes provided for in the state's "Business Tax Act" (Tennessee Code Annotated, § 67-4-701, et seq.) are hereby expressly enacted, ordained, and levied on the businesses, business activities, vocations, and occupations carried on within the city at the rates and in the manner prescribed by the act.

6-202. License required. No person shall exercise any such privilege within the city without a currently effective privilege license, which shall be issued by the recorder to each applicant therefore upon the applicant's payment of the appropriate privilege tax. Violations of this section shall be punished under the general penalty provisions of this code of ordinances.

Effective Date. June 1st, 2008.

Repealer Provisions. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Alderman Blalack made a motion to pass Ordinance #03102010-1 to amend the Brighton Municipal Code, Section 6, Chapter 2, Privilege Taxes in order to comply with the Laws of the State of Tennessee in regards to Municipal Business Tax with an effective date of June 1, 2008 retroactive to 2006 on the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith. The motion passed on the second reading.

Alderman Blalack made a motion to pass Ordinance #03092010-2 to amend the Town of Brighton Municipal Code to adopt the INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE by Reference on the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith. The motion passed on the second reading.

Alderman Blalack made a motion to pass Ordinance #03092010-3 to amend the Town of Brighton Municipal Code to adopt the INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL FOR ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLINGS, INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE, INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, INTERNATIONAL EXISTING BUILDING CODE, INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE, AND INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE by Reference on the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith. The motion passed on the second reading.

Alderman Blalack made a motion to pass Ordinance #03092010-4 to amend the Brighton Municipal Code, Section 5, Chapter 1, which outlines the purchasing policies of the Town of Brighton and hereby enacts that purchases not exceeding \$5,000.00 do not require formal sealed bids or written specifications and purchases in excess of \$5,000.00 (not exceeding \$10,000.00) require written specifications and have to be awarded by written contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder following advertisement and the submission of sealed bids, on the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith. The motion passed on the second reading.
