

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX 74 ACRES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF AKINS STORE ROAD WEST OF HIGHWAY 51

WHEREAS, Section 6-51-102 Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, provides for annexation of territory to be a municipality after notice of Public Hearing relative to said annexation; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held before this body on the 13th day of November, 2001, and notice thereof, published in the Covington Leader, and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Brighton:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the authority conferred by Section 6-51-102, Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, there is hereby annexed to the Town of Brighton, Tennessee, and incorporated within the corporate boundaries thereof, approximately 74 acres located on the south side of Akins Store Road, west of Highway 51. The plan of services is also adopted through this Ordinance and the property zoned R-Residential. (See attached map)

SECTION 2. Should any provision or part of this Ordinance be rendered void or unenforceable by any court of law, statute or other authority, the rest and remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.

Alderman Hill made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting as written. Alderman Watkins seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Alderman Watkins made a motion to approve the annexation of approximately 74 acres of land currently in the Brighton Annexation Reserve area on the south side of Akins Store Road, west of Highway 51 (Map 80, Parcel 35) on the second and final reading and public hearing. Alderman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed on the second and final reading and the public hearing.

Alderman Scott made a motion to pass an amendment to the Brighton Municipal-Regional Subdivision Regulations altering ARTICLE V, Section A-4, paragraph d (page V-3) and ARTICLE V, Section E-2 to change the wording to require private ownership and maintenance of stormwater detention basins within residential subdivisions on the public hearing and second and final reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hill. The motion passed on the public hearing and second and final reading.

Alderman Watkins made a motion to pay our bills. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hill. The motion passed.

Alderman Scott made a motion to approve the purchase of turn-out gear for two firemen from the Brighton Fire Department in the amount of \$2,400.00. Alderman Watkins seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Alderman Hill made a motion to approve the purchase of dress tops and badges for all of the Brighton firemen at a cost of \$1,600.00 of which half will be paid by the Brighton Fire Department and half will come out of the Fire Department budget. The motion was seconded by Alderman Scott. The motion passed.

Alderman Scott made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Alderman Watkins. The motion passed, we stand adjourned.
