

ORDINANCE 12132006

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 10302006 WHICH AMENDED THE BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE FOUND WITHIN THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF BRIGHTON, TENNESSEE BY AMENDING THE FLOOD MAP REFERENCE DATE IN ARTICLE III, SUBSECTION (B) OF THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated* Sections 13-7-201 through 13-7-211, a Municipal Zoning Ordinance has been adopted for City of Brighton, Tennessee; and,

WHEREAS, the Brighton Municipal-Regional Planning Commission has reviewed the aforementioned proposed amendment to the text of the Municipal Zoning Ordinance, and recommended to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that said amendment become adopted; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated* Section 13-7-203 and 13-7-303, a public hearing was held, the time and place of which was published with fifteen days advance notice and held on _____, 2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That Article III, General Provisions, Section A of the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, Subsection (B) of the Municipal Zoning Ordinance of Brighton, Tennessee be deleted in it's entirety and replaced with the following:

B. Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard

The Areas of Special Flood Hazard identified on the Brighton, Tennessee, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), Community Panel Number 470340, dated 12-19-2006, along with all supporting technical data, are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, THE WELFARE OF THE TOWN REQUIRING IT.
