A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION (S) FOR FY 2024 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development administers the Community Development Block Grant Program that was established to assist local governments in meeting community development and housing needs consistent with the objectives as set forth in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brighton acting by and through its Mayor and Board of Aldermen proposes to apply for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the purpose of performing eligible community development activities that will benefit residents of the Town of Brighton.

WHEREAS, the Town of Brighton will provide local financial support in conjunction with the CDBG funds to complete the eligible project(s); and

WHEREAS, an applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Brighton as follows:


THAT, Stephanie Chapman-Washam, Mayor, or successor in title, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the State of Tennessee, Department of Economic and Community Development, requesting Fiscal Year 2024 Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 per project, for Drainage Improvement Project(s); and

THAT, the Town of Brighton will be responsible for the local cash/match to be provided in full by the general account; and

THAT, Stephanie Chapman-Washam, Mayor, or successor in Title, be and is hereby designated and authorized to sign the application(s) and contract or grant documents for receipt and to take all actions necessary to implement and complete grant activities on behalf of the Town of Brighton, Tennessee
