#### **Council approves resolution bringing new cancer mitigating equipment to Cape Coral Fire Department**

The City Council approved Resolution 2-22, which authorizes an agreement between the City of Cape Coral and the State of Florida to procure new Fire Department equipment that mitigates exposure to hazardous, cancer-causing chemicals through an apparatus bay ventilation system.

The funds for the new equipment, which comes via the Firefighter Cancer Decontamination Grant, will be installed at Cape Coral Fire Station 5 on Diplomat Pkwy East.

#### **Appointments to boards and committees**

The City Council filled five vacancies tonight on the Community Development Block Grant and one of two vacancies on the Golf Course Advisory Board.

#### **Economic Development Manager title changed**

The Council voted this evening to change the title of the Economic Development Manager to Economic and Business Development Officer. City Manager Rob Hernandez says the recommended change more accurately describes the scope of the job. In addition to economic development, Mr. Hernandez said, "This position also works to strengthen local business and also to adopt terminology that's more consistent with their counterparts in the private sector."
