



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the August 2, 2023, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Community Recognition: American Legion Post 90

City Council and the City Manager recognize Cape Coral’s American Legion Post 90 for earning the prestigious American Legion Media Alliance Award for Best Public Relations Program. Post 90 competed against 95 other American Legion Posts and were judged on their external public relations outreach efforts.

Council Approves Increase in Funding for Treatment of Harmful Algal Bloom

City Council approved resolution 191-23, approving an increase in funding for the purchase of equipment and operating expenses, funded by the City’s Stormwater Fund for preparations, response, and recovery activities related to harmful algal blooms.

City Council Approves MOU to Resolve Waste Pro Dispute

The City entered into a Solid Waste Collection Contract with Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. dated April 15, 2010. A contractual dispute arose between the parties and Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. filed an action against the City of Cape Coral in the Lee County Circuit Court, Case No. 2023-CA-000034. In an effort to resolve the contractual dispute, the parties entered into Mediation on May 15, 2023. At the Mediation, the parties resolved their issues and came to the agreement set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and Mutual Release between City of Cape Coral and Waste Pro of Florida, Inc., subject to approval of the City Council.

Tonight, City Council approved the MOU and Mutual Release to resolve the contractual dispute and settlement of the case.
