








North 1 East Booster Pump Station and Tanks Estimated Construction Cost of \$20 Million










North 1 East Master Pump Station 725 Estimated Construction Cost of \$9.0 Million









- Funded by FHWA (80%) and City of Cape Coral (20%).
- LFA Approved \$25,636.28
- Est. Design Start: May 2024
- Est. Design Cost: \$130,000 +/-
- Est. Construction Start: TBD
- Est. Construction Cost: \$500,000

B.) Repair of Bridge Structures 125717 (NB Span) and 125718 (SB Span) located over the Eternity Canal on Sands Boulevard, north of El Dorado Parkway W.:

- Funded by FHWA (80%) and City of Cape Coral (20%).
- LFA Approved \$22,011.27
- Est. Design Start: May 2024
- Est. Design Cost: \$110,000 +/-
- Est. Construction Start: TBD
- Est. Construction Cost: \$500,000

Oasis Multi-Purpose Athletic Field


- \$800,000 Design and Permitting Budget

- Permitting 70% Complete
- Budget on Track
- Projected construction completion (subject to permitting & bidding) -June 2025
