

- Estimated \$250 Million per year in Projects




#### North 1 West UEP - \$250 Million







#### North 1 East - \$225 Million

- 1,260,000 SF
- \$237,120 Fee
- Stantec Consulting Services, Inc.
- 50% Complete
- The intent of the plan is to provide adequate and efficient workspace for employees, vehicles and equipment storage.

  - 100% Complete Including Inspections after Hurricane Ian

### 28 Weirs Rehabilitation Program with Utilities \$1 Million Per Year








- AIM Engineering selected for Structural Engineering Services

  - 95% Complete





## **D&D Boat Ramp**


\$304,000 Design and Permitting is 60% complete. AECOM is proceeding with 90% plans.



- Design and Permitting RFP's Due on July 20, 2023.


#### **Design Elements:**

- Recreation Offices
- Two (2) Classrooms
- General Seating/Covered Seating

- \$15,000,000 Project Estimate
- In May 2023, SAC selected Johnson Engineering for Design and Permitting

## Misc. Capital Improvement Projects

- Sirenia Vista Park Modular Restroom Project \$529,650 Construction Cost Completion August 2023 - On Schedule and Budget (Lee County Tourists Development Council (TDC) Grant in the amount of \$406,690)
- Burnt Store Rd. Boat Ramp Sewer Improvements \$265,325 Construction Cost Completed On Schedule and Under Budget
- Providing technical support for the South Spreader Waterway Environmental Improvement and Sustainability Program Permit
