



The following are highlights from the April 20, 2022, Cape Coral City Council meeting in case you missed the meeting.

City Council Approves Hancock Bridge Drainage Improvements

Resolution 64-22 approves the Staffing Cost Proposal between the City of Cape Coral and Black & Veatch Corporation to provide professional design services for the Hancock Bridge Parkway Drainage Improvements project. The project aims to reduce flooding on Hancock Bridge Parkway and the surrounding neighborhoods.

City Council Approves LeeTran Interlocal Agreement

On October 13th, 2021, City Council directed staff to develop an agreement with the Lee County Department of LeeTran to manage the amenities (benches, shelters, trash cans, etc.) at bus stops on transit routes. At tonight’s meeting, City Council approved Resolution 70-22, a 10-year interlocal agreement between Lee County and the City of Cape Coral for transit service.

City Council Approves School Bus Lease Agreement

Resolution 80-22 authorizes the City to enter into a Master Equipment Lease Purchase Agreement with Pinnacle Public Finance, Inc. to finance the lease-purchase of vehicles, including school buses for the City's charter schools.

City Council Approves Ad Valorem Tax Exemption

Voters will decide on the referendum in the General Election scheduled for November 8, 2022. Ordinance 31-22 provides a referendum to consider the adoption of an Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption, which grants limited tax exemptions to developers of specific projects to facilitate the growth and creation of business enterprises in Cape Coral.

Gator Circle Neighborhood Park Name Introduced

Ordinance 37-22 proposes the official name, “Gator Trails Park.” The Public Hearing for this ordinance is set for May 4, 2022. The City enlisted the community’s help in naming Gator Circle Park, which is expected to open later this year.
