



**In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the November 16, 2022, Cape Coral City Council meeting.**

**Council Approves Acceptance of Marine Education and Enforcement Grant**

City Council approved resolution 221-22 accepting the West Coast Inland Navigation District subgrant for Marine Education and Enforcement for police department personnel. Funding for the grant is available from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023, and funds will be used to conduct on-water education and enforcement.

**Council Approves Reclassification of DSD Positions**

City Council approved Resolution 246-22, creating two new position classifications, "Permit Technician" and "Permit Specialist", both within the Development Services Department (DSD). The resolution stems from the Development Services Department and is to reclassify Customer Service Representatives from the DSD Customer Service Division into Permit Technicians and to reclassify Senior Customer Service Representatives into Permit Specialists.
