

## PROGRAMS



### HOUSING REHABILITATION, RECONSTRUCTION, AND/OR ELEVATION (HRRE)

- Funding helps repair, reconstruct, replace, and/or elevate hurricane damaged homes
- Eligible applicants include: income eligible single-family homeowners and rental-property owners who intend to rent to income qualified renters
- Eligible properties include: concrete block homes, stick built homes, mobile homes



### HOME PURCHASE ASSISTANCE (HPA)

- Assists income eligible home buyers with funding to purchase an eligible primary residence outside the floodplain within Lee County
- Assistance may include closing costs, down payment assistance, mortgage rate buy down, and more



### VOLUNTARY RESIDENTIAL ACQUISITION (VRA)

- Provides income eligible homeowners with repetitive flood loss an opportunity to relocate outside of the flood zone

## Lee Cares Hurricane Ian Housing Recovery Program Overview

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development allocated Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery funding to Lee County, Florida to address the disaster recovery needs of residents impacted by Hurricane Ian in 2022. Funding is available to eligible residents through one of three programs: Lee County Housing Rehabilitation, Reconstruction and Elevation Program (HRRE), Home Purchase Assistance Program (HPA) and the Voluntary Residential Acquisition Program (VRAP).
