1. Hancock Bridge Parkway Drainage Improvements – Design complete


a) A study was conducted to determine the cause of flooding on a neighborhood scale surrounding Hancock Bridge Pkwy. Multiple design alternatives were provided to the City for cost-benefit evaluation. The selected method was designed and submitted for

construction.





## **Waterways Stakeholders Group Process**

#### Formation and maintenance of the Group:


- o Interested Cape Coral residents can apply by contacting the Public Works Director or be nominated by a Councilmember.
- Applicants evaluated by the Public Works Director based on:
  - Diversity of geographic location; experience as Canalwatch volunteer or Waterway Board member or similar; diversity of interests of applicants; background, education and experience in water-related matters.
- Maximum of 10 members, eligible to be Stakeholders for 2 years.
- Development of a Mission, Code of Conduct, and Meetings Agendas by Public Works.
- Topics of discussion established by Public Works, consulted, and amended at the end of each meeting by the Group, pending Director's approval of Agenda before following meeting.
- Annual re-evaluation of the Group by the Public Works Director, based on reaffirmation of interest by each Stakeholder, attendance conduct and contribution during meetings.
- Advertisement of Stakeholders application period and meetings through the office of Communication using Press Releases, Social media and website postings.

#### Organization of the meetings:

- Advertisement and agenda planning 1 month in advance, at a minimum
- Quarterly meeting at a minimum, 2-hours long, with remote option available
- o Facilitated by city staff, with allocated time for each Stakeholder's input, review of previous and future deliverables
- o Review of discussion topics and meeting schedule at each meeting for flexible adaptation to current events
- City staff will take notes and send summary of meeting to Stakeholders Group for feedback before following meeting
