

# Cape Coral, FL Supplemental Online Survey Results

2017



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# **About this Report**

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey<sup>TM</sup>, the City of Cape Coral conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in April 2017 and data were collected through May 31, 2017. Towards the end of the official data collection period (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Cape Coral, FL, 2017*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from May 17 to June 27, 2017 and 827 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of Cape Coral.
