In accordance with order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020, the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas will conduct a telephonic meeting in order to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

This Emergency Special Meeting will be held on Friday, April 3, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. The stated emergency is to ensure that no one is put out of their residence which can further community spread of the virus. In the last week there have been 7 reported positive COVID-19 cases reported out of PVAMU, showing clear indications of recent and progressive community spread within the City of Prairie View, necessitating this meeting on an emergency basis.
