#### "City of Prairie View set to implement K-9 Program"

Perhaps the most profitable investment a community can make is establishing a POLICE K-9 UNIT. A K-9 unit will deter drug trafficking in our community, help officers apprehend criminals in dangerous situations and eliminate wasted man-hours while protecting the officer at the same time.

The K-9 acquired is certified both in searching for narcotics, as well as in tracking and article searching. If a person was lost in the woods or fled a crime scene, the K-9 would be able to track and locate the person much faster and more precisely than human officers.

Prairie View's population is made of young children and elderly adults. When someone goes missing, no matter what age, time is a factor, especially during colder weather. A K-9 is able to track a missing person much quicker than a human police officer, and in some cases, this could be the difference between life and death for the lost or missing individual.

We would like to give a huge thanks to Southern Growls for the donation of the K-9 Dog and also thanks to the Harris County Sherriff Department for donating 12 weeks of free training for the K-9 and its Handler.
