**Sec. 13.902 Trash
 Receptacles in the Right-
 of-Way for Garbage**

Service (a) A trash receptacle may only be placed and/or left in the right-of-way for garbage service between the hours of 6:00 p.m., the day before pick-up is scheduled and 6:00 p.m. the day of trash pick-up. (b) An offense under this subsection shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) or more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
