Prairie View;**

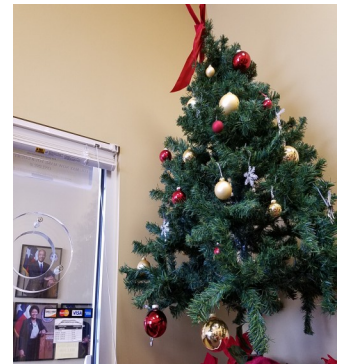
