

Prairie View is becoming home to the largest

cricket complex in the United States with 12-14 fields.

The 84 acres for the complex has been purchased and will be on Hwy 290 at Richards Road to Liendo Parkway, just on the other side of Hwy 290 from our new 1,400 bed/bath student housing project with 5 acres of retail being added.

Cricket is the 2nd biggest sport in the world behind soccer.

Two fields will be built to International Cricket standards with seating for up to 10,000 fans.

Prairie View A&M University's Professor Barry Norwood and students in the College of Architecture are designing the layout for fields.

The owner will also be building a Pizza Hut, KFC restaurant and a


