

MINUTES OF THE COLERAIN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS – the Regular Monthly Meeting Wednesday February 19, 2020 of the Colerain Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Walter L. Todd, Jr. with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge to the Flag. Supervisors present were: Walter L. Todd, Jr., and Scott E. Shoemaker. Samuel R. Reinhart was absent. Carmen B. Wiker, Secretary was also present. A listing of others in attendance will be kept on file.

As per the revision to the Sunshine Law dated 12/98, the audience was advised that the agenda was available to them. Each agenda item will be introduced, motioned and seconded by the Supervisor(s), item will be opened for discussion for the board, and then the audience, and then a vote called for by the Chairman. The Chairman will again ask for any comments the audience may have at the end of the meeting.

Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting February 3, 2020 were approved as read.

Unpaid Bills- General Fund and Park Fund

The Bills on Hand were reviewed. *A motion was made by Walter L. Todd, Jr. and seconded by Scott E. Shoemaker to approve paying bills totaling \$ 21,772.12. Walt called for the vote – All voted “Aye” – motion carried.*

Sewage Enforcement

- Levi Stoltzfus of 85 Sproul- Marvin Stoner sent a letter revoking the Sewage Permit for this project. The Sewage Permit application was for a four- bedroom single family home but the actual home being built is for a seven-bedroom double house. The Building plans were submitted correctly; Levi’s plans were to only live in one half of the house for the next couple of years. This caused confusion somewhere during the process. For this type of home, a DEP Planning Module is required. After speaking to the Solicitor, the Supervisors decided to not revoke the building permit. Instead a Use & Occupancy Permit will not be issued until the proper approved system is installed. Levi asked if Holding Tanks would be a possibility as the Planning Module could take up to nine months to complete. Scott agreed to talk to Marvin Stoner about the Holding Tanks.
