

DIRECTIONAL SIGN APPLICATION

Directional Signs are intended to provide a safe and uniform means to direct the general public from the main traffic corridors of Route 472 (Kirkwood Pike), Route 896 (Georgetown Road), Noble Road and Maple Shade Road to businesses within Colerain Township.

1. No sign shall be wider than 9 inches or longer than 36 inches. All signs are to be white letters on a blue background and uniform in shape and shall only contain the name and direction to the business.
2. No establishment shall erect, place, install or maintain more than three signs within the Township and no more than one sign at any street intersection.
3. No more than three signs may be placed at any one corner of a street intersection. Co-location of multiple signs on a single post is required.
4. Directional Signs will be purchased and installed by the Township for uniformity.
5. The location of any Directional Sign shall be approved by the Roadmaster.
6. Replacement costs for materials, wear and tear of signs and/or damage to same will be at the expense of the Applicant. Township will bill owner for any expense of maintaining the sign.
7. Should business cease operation or change name, etc., it will be the business owner's responsibility to notify the Township to remove or change the sign, at the owner's expense.
8. Signs must be for businesses located within the Township only.
