

Recycling Services

CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE...

Is provided by licensed haulers and they are required by the County to offer this service. There is generally no extra charge for recycling service! It's easy, just call your hauler and ask for it and a list of what you can put in the bin!

RURAL DROP-OFF DEPOTS...

Are available for people that do not have curbside service.



The Depots are available at the following locations around the County:

Berne— next to the church building

Claremont—by the City Shop

Dodge Center— north of the City Maintenance Shop

Hayfield—next to the County Shed, N of Hwy 30 on Center St.

Kasson/Mantorville— Gate C at the Recycling Center

West Concord—County Hwy Shop 195 Front St

Ellington, Concord, Westfield and Vernon - Township Halls

GARBAGE COLLECTION

CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION is provided by licensed haulers. All haulers are required to offer their customers with volume based pricing..."so the less you throw away, the less you pay". Call Dodge County for names of licensed haulers.



RURAL GARBAGE COLLECTION can be provided by licensed haulers, but it may be hard to find a hauler to service remote areas. If hauling service is not available, garbage is accepted at the Dodge County Transfer Station. Fees are based on weight and volume of waste. Another option is the Self-Serve Waste Depot—ask about it in the Transfer Station Office.

DODGE COUNTY TRANSFER STATION accepts waste from haulers, businesses, and residents. Waste is then transported to the Olmsted Waste-to-Energy Facility where it is converted into steam and electricity.

RECYCLE THESE MATERIALS

Items below are accepted at the Dodge County Recycling Drop-Off Depots.

Newspapers, Junk Mail, Magazines, Office Paper, Envelopes & BoxBoard

(Cereal box type)

- bundle in paper sacks or dump it loose; do not tie & **NO PLASTIC BAGS**, please!
- Include inserts from newspapers, envelopes & junk mail
- **NO** tissue paper, napkins, towels
- **NO** padded /bubble wrap envelopes
- **YES** colored paper is accepted



Corrugated Cardboard

(Layered with wavy center)

- flatten & bundle together
- NO** waxy coated or food contaminated boxes, i.e. frozen & microwave food



Aseptic Containers

- ½ gallon milk and juice cartons
- Soup, broth and cream containers
- rinse clean



Tin/Steel/Aluminum Cans

- empty & rinse
- remove loose lids



Glass Bottles & Jars

- rinse clean
- NO** LIDS... Please!!
- NO** ceramic dishes or mugs, window glass or Plexiglass, lights bulbs, glassware or Pyrex



Plastics

- rinse clean
- All Narrow Neck bottles
- Plastic containers #1, #2 and #5



Less than 8" in diameter

- Lids are accepted on beverage containers
- **NO** toys, car parts, diapers, furniture, laundry baskets or car seats

DO NOT BAG your recycling – Please put in the bin loose.

When using the Dodge County Drop-Off locations **PLEASE... follow instructions on the bins.**

IF YOU HAVE CURBSIDE RECYCLING... please contact your hauler to see what is and is not acceptable in your bin.
