Absentee Voting – General Election 2022

Absentee Voting Period: September 23 – November 7

Location for voting in person by absentee:

Dodge County Government Services Building 721 Main Street North Mantorville, MN

Hours for voting:

- During normal office hours 8:00 am 4:30 pm, Monday Friday, beginning 46 days before the election;
- The Saturday before the election (November 5) from 10:00 am 3:00 pm; or
- The Monday before the election (November 7) from 8:00 am 5:00 pm.

Availability of Absentee Ballot Applications

- Absentee ballots are available 46 days prior to the state general election. You <u>must</u> complete an Application to Vote by Absentee Ballot form in order to receive an absentee ballot. (link provided below)
- An eligible voter may vote by absentee ballot in person at the Government Services Building during the times listed above or they may choose to have their absentee ballot mailed to them.

Returning Absentee Ballots

You may return your completed absentee ballot in-person using one of the following methods:

- During normal office hours 8:00 am 4:30 pm, Monday Friday, beginning 46 days before the election;
- On the Saturday before the election (November 5) from 10:00 am 3:00 pm; or
- On the Monday before the election (November 7) until 5:00 pm
- On the Tuesday of the election (November 8) until 3:00 pm

You may also return your completed absentee ballot by the mail.

- The ballot must be received at the Dodge County Government Services Building by Election Day (<u>not</u> Postmarked on election day).
