Danesville (Ghost Town)

LOCATION: 590th St and 280th Ave, Mantorville, MN 55955

STATUS: Private

TYPE: Historic, District

HISTORY: Established in 1868, east of Mantorville and northwest of Byron. Because of prohibition, this village moved across the road to Olmsted County.

The store was once on the Dodge County side of the road. During a certain time during prohibition when Dodge County was “dry” they moved the store across the road to Olmsted. To the north, two large farms with a grove of trees, old silo, and shed are included.
