Dodge County Courthouse

LOCATION: 22 6th St E, Mantorville, MN 55955

STATUS: Public, Active Courthouse/Government Center

TYPE: Historic, Architecture, Local

HISTORY: This building houses Dodge County offices. The construction of the limestone structure with its 40-inch-thick walls was begun in 1865 and completed in 1871. Repairs were needed in 1890 after a windstorm tore off part of the roof. Additional office space was added in 1990. Today, it is the oldest working courthouse in Minnesota.
