To: Residents and Business Owners in the vicinity of Rogers Bridge

This letter serves as a notification regarding construction of a new pedestrian bridge at the site of historic Rogers Bridge over the Chattahoochee River. We are pleased and excited to report that construction on the new bridge has begun!

The new Rogers Bridge over the Chattahoochee River be a replica of the existing historic bridge which will be removed from the River later this year. It will have a 14' wide walking/cycling path and will connect the Cities of Duluth (in Gwinnett County) and Johns Creek (in Fulton County). This long awaited project also includes a water line replacement to allow the existing 30" water line that resides on the old bridge deck, to take up new residence underneath the new bridge deck. You'll see it in its new form as you tube down the River in the future.

As our number one concern remains the safety of the public, the City has closed off sections of Rogers Bridge Park to allow us (the contractor) to conduct our construction operations without impacting the general public. The park sections that are closed include the canoe launch, the pavilions, the restrooms, and the playground. The Chattahoochee Dog Park and its associated parking area remain open.

We expect the bridge construction to be substantially complete by the summer of 2022, and as such, these sections of Rogers Bridge Park will remain closed until that time. A gate has been installed on Rogers Bridge Road to prevent vehicles from entering. For your safety, we ask that you not enter the gate at any time.

If using the River, we ask that you put in downstream of the Rogers Bridge boat ramp, or take out upstream of the Rogers Bridge boat ramp.
