
**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES DURING  
PANDEMIC EMERGENCY**

As a result of the viral pandemic currently existing, and for the protection of the court users and staff, the Court hereby enters this Order, which shall remain in effect until rescinded, and which supersedes and replaces the Order entered on August 20, 2021, concerning COVID-19 protocols and procedures.

All visitors and court users will be subject to temperature screening upon entrance to the Court facility for a court session. Any person having a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be admitted. All visitors and court users shall be required to wear a mask covering the nose and mouth while attending any court session. Any person who enters the court facility for a court session is certifying that he or she is free of COVID-19 symptoms and known exposure that poses a significant threat of infection. In this connection, all visitors entering the courtroom shall respond to the screening statements set out in Exhibit "A" of this Order.

This Order shall be posted at the courthouse entrance, on the Court's website, and the City Website.

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SCREENING STATEMENTS

\_\_\_\_\_ I attest that I have not traveled to a high-risk area or location identified as a “hot spot” of confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) cases within the last 14 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ To the best of my knowledge, I have not had contact with a person confirmed or presumed to have coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days.

\_\_\_\_\_ I attest that I have not experienced any difficulty breathing or persistent cough within the last 14 days. I further attest that, within the last 14 days, I have not experienced at least two of the following symptoms: fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pains, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.

\_\_\_\_\_ To the best of my knowledge, I am not currently experiencing any upper respiratory illnesses accompanied by a fever.

\_\_\_\_\_ I affirm that I have not tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) according to a confirmed test from a medical provider or pharmacy within the last 14 days.

If a visitor is unable to attest or respond to the above statements, the visitor will be directed to the court window for further instructions.

NOTE

All visitors who are members of a vulnerable population (such as persons over 65, individuals with serious underlying health conditions such as high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and those whose immune systems are compromised, such as by chemotherapy for cancer or other conditions requiring therapy) should bring that to the attention of court personnel so that reasonable alternatives to appearing in person today can be explored.
