

Protect your every day. **RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS OF SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY**



What is suspicious activity?

Suspicious activity could be anything out of the ordinary or considered "not normal" for the circumstances. It is any activity that makes you feel uncomfortable, or just "doesn't seem right."

Examples of Suspicious Activity

- A vehicle you don't recognize is parked in your neighborhood (occupied or unoccupied) at odd hours or in a strange location (ie. backed into a cul-de-sac).
- A vehicle you don't recognize passes through the neighborhood several times, or is moving slowly as if checking out homes.
- A vehicle that you don't recognize is parked at a neighbor's house during a time you know the neighbor is not at home (ie. during the day, while they are away at work or while they are on vacation)
- You notice there is a home in the neighborhood where there are large amounts of vehicular traffic coming and going all the time. The vehicular traffic seems to be more than what a normal family would have coming and going during the day or night, and it never seems to be the same vehicles.
- You see an unfamiliar person or persons walking around the neighborhood or going door to door.

Information to give police when reporting information:

1. Where the suspicious activity is taking place.
2. A description of the activity, and why you feel it is suspicious.
3. A description of the person you are calling about to include: gender, race, age, height, weight, clothing, a direction the person was last headed in, and where they were last seen.
4. A description of the vehicle to include: color, make, model, if it is occupied-how many people are in the vehicle, a description of the person driving, a tag number (if it can safely be obtained), and a direction the vehicle was last headed.
5. Any other information you feel is important to pass on to police.
