

## **Legal Notice - Notification of Marketing of Rogers Bridge**

Duluth, GA

*The cities of Duluth and Johns Creek, GA are seeking a responsible party to take ownership of historic Rogers Bridge. In accordance with Title 23 of the United States Code, Section 144, the cities are seeking to donate the bridge to a State, Locality, or Responsible Private Entity. Recipient must enter into an agreement to maintain the bridge and the features that give it its historical significance, assume all future legal and financial responsibility for the bridge, and hold the Georgia Department of Transportation, Fulton and Gwinnett Counties, and the cities of Johns Creek and Duluth harmless in any liability action. Recipient will bear all cost to carefully dismantle, ship, and rebuild the bridge in its new location. The following information is offered to potential recipients:*

- *Constructed in the early 1900's. No construction documents are available.*
- *Is a pin-connected Pennsylvania Petit type through truss bridge with a main truss span of 228'. Maximum truss height at mid-span is 33'-3".*
- *Eligible for the National Register of Historic Places as representative of early 20<sup>th</sup> Century design and fabrication methods.*
- *Has severely diminished structural capacity, requiring rehabilitation to approximately 90% of the structure.*
