Ms. Wines said Vogue will be painted as well as the Stockman's Hotel and Casino will be painted and thinks it will look amazing. In total, there will be 55 walls. They are looking for donations to fund the projects from various businesses. There is still time to hire artists.

Mica Johnson advised there is a schedule that will be out soon.

Ms. Wines advised lunches will be provided from Dreez, Coffee Mug, Luciano's and Port of Subs. Dreez is donating appetizers for the closing night. Everyone who donates will be getting tote bags, t-shirts and other various items.

Bailey Billington-Benson suggested a certificate of appreciation from the Mayor's Office for each sponsor.
