APPROVAL OF MINUTES November 3, 2021 Regular Session

The minutes have the wrong date on them.

I. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the arts brochure, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Chairwoman Catherine Wines said that the brochure icons will still need to be finished. She noted the email between her and the lady making the brochures (EXAMPLE A).

Scott gave Catherine a copy of the email that was sent out.

Catherine stated her email did not show up like it did on his.

There was discussion about what to include on the map and what to fill the white spaces with.

Cynthia Delaney stated she didn't have time to look at it.

Chairwoman Wines said there is an opportunity to put another picture on the brochure. She suggested Lamoille Canyon as the photo.

Cynthia Delaney said that the picture of Lamoille Canyon would look good and it would look spectacular with the sunsets.

Ms. Wines asked Ms. Delaney if she had any pictures to put on the brochure.

Ms. Delaney said she could look through and see if there were any pictures. She asked if a sunset picture would work.

Ms. Wines would like the picture of the Basque feet.

Ms. Delaney questioned if that picture could go vertically because it is a horizontal photo and could use the Basque photo and put it on the bottom. It could block off the text but will look through her photos to see what will work.

Ms. Wines also dissed the front panel of the brochure. She is not fond of the wording "Elko Art Map." She suggested "Elko Arts."

Ms. Delaney said she liked "Elko Arts," but the wording needed to be bigger

Ms. Wines agrees and the wording needs to be brought to the top more. She mentioned the balloon on the map should stay. The brochure is getting close to finish with the updates mentioned in the email (EXAMPLE A).

***** A motion was made by Cynthia Delaney, seconded by Mica Johnson, to authorize the Chairwoman Catherine Wines, to work directly with the artist to finalize all details on the map and brochure.**

The motion passed unanimously (3-0).

B. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the 2026 Sestercentennial Art Project, and matters related thereto. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Chairwoman Wines stated last September they partnered with the Flag Foundation to have large letters that read, “We the People.” The Flag Foundation is excited about the project. Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), has been contacted due to the letters being directly beside the I-80. NDOT does not believe they need approval but they will need to be involved in communication. The next step would be to have the project presented to the City Council to start fundraising. The Elko Art Foundation can be used as a way to collect money for fundraising the project as the fiscal agent.

***** A motion was made by Cynthia Delaney, seconded by Mica Johnson, to speak to the City Council about the Sestercentennial Art Project and authorize Catherine Wines to use the Arts and Culture Advisory Board to have the Flag Foundation and/or The Elko Art’s Foundation as (a) fiscal agent(s).**

The motion passed unanimously (3-0).

C. Review, discussion and possible action on the Power Box Project, and matters related thereto. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Ms. Delaney has looked through the photos that were presented and the Elko Daily achieves. She feels that the pictures are too busy. Her suggestion would be to use the ones that will work but also approach local photographers. She stated the photo would have to be donated due to lack of funds.

Chairwoman Wines asked Mr. Wilkinson if they would be able to give them \$100.00.

Mr. Wilkinson stated he suggested to get the photographers and see if they are willing to donate their work or if they would need to be paid and how much. At the next meeting they could decide once the information is gathered.

Ms. Johnson suggested the past Fair winners could be a possibility for photographers.

Ms. Delaney asked what the subject matter was such as a events, scenery, or something that is visually compelling. Something to look at are primary colors and she will ask around for photographers.

***** A motion was made by Mica Johnson, seconded by Cynthia Delaney, to have Cynthia Delaney to reach out to local photographers to see if they will possibly donate their work for the Power box Project and allow for discussion on the next meeting.**

The motion passed unanimously (3-0).

D. Review, discussion and possible action on the Community Tree Projects, and matters related thereto. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Chairwoman Wines discussed having a metal Christmas tree by the tower with a tree lighting ceremony. Mandy Simons is looking into the tree and will not be complete by this year.
