I. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the arts brochure, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Ms. Wines had reviewed the brochure. There were a few adjustments and the brochure is getting updated. Once the brochure is updated, it will go to the board for final approval.

- B. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the arts festival in collaboration with the Elko Art Foundation, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Ms. Wines goes over the Elko Art's Foundation, which will serve as an arts council. She mentioned an art's council has been a part of the original master plan with this board. The Elko Art Foundation is planning a miniature Art's Festival, on

September 11, 2021, that will take place downtown. In the previous meeting for this board, the Arts and Culture advisory board will be requesting a donation from the Elko City Council to help fund the miniature Art's Festival. This will happen when the City Council is reviewing the final budget.

- C. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the official date of the Mayor's Arts Awards, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Ms. Wines showed the Mayor's Art Award to the board.

The board discussed having the Mayor's Arts Award for the years 2020 and 2021, rather than just the year 2020.

Ms. Wines advised that she will get the name plates together and work with Kim Wilkinson, Administrative Assistant for the City of Elko.

***** A motion was made by Councilwoman Mandy Simons, seconded by Cynthia Delaney, to hold the 2020/2021 Mayor's Arts Award tentatively August 4, 2021.**

The motion passed unanimously (3-0).

- D. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the 2026 Sestorcentennial Art Project, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Ms. Wines advised that this board has had a project for important anniversaries and it would be good to plan early. She discussed the flag as an important part of Elko.

Ms. Delaney agreed and said it will be a very patriotic celebration.

Councilwoman Simons suggested a pedestal under the flag.

Ms. Wines suggested a large script saying "We the People," that is visible from the freeway.

Ms. Wines said that this will stay on the agenda and continue to work on it and follow up with the Flag Committee.

- E. Review, discussion, and possible action concerning the art pedestals on the block end construction project in the downtown parking corridor, and matters related thereto. **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

Ms. Wines said originally there were pedestals but they were removed.

Councilwoman Simons suggested after speaking to them that the committee could design a large art piece and go from there and advised that it could be completed quickly, with that information.

Ms. Wines said that she has contacted artists that have displayed at burning man.

The board disused the weight, dimensions and the size of the piece with the area.

Councilwoman Simons said the holdup is the dimensions. Once they start building then contracts would go next.

Ms. Wines said the board could come up with a size. She advised she would reach out to the Burning Man artists for the sizes.

The board reviewed the sketches and discussed wood chips as a potential material. Once this is completed, the designs would go to review with the City engineer.

***** A motion was made by Councilwoman Mandy Simons, seconded by Cynthia Delaney, to make the decision to have the pedestals the full 20 feet diameter 10 feet radius and 18 inches high, going above the ground. If possible, have the inside of the “D” shape organic material for anchoring.**

The motion passed unanimously (3-0).
