***** PLEASE NOTE RECEIPT OF ADDENDUM NUMBER THREE ON APPLICABLE LINE ON SUBMITTED BID PROPOSAL *****



Clarification:

- Q. What other infrastructure exists within the City other than the Water Tanks and Tower?
A. Street Lights are to be considered, we will provide a shape file if it is available.

Clarification: City owned Street Lights and Traffic Signals can be used. The City does not a shape file for these assets, but can work with vendors for locations if these assets are required.

- Q. Do we have a preference on power loss?
A. This question will need further discussion and consideration before we can answer.

Clarification: Please provide any information in your proposal on how your products would accommodate loss of power. i.e. Examples or situations can be included and the way this is handled.

- Q. Regarding the retro-fit options, how will we determine the difference of the two wire units vs. three wire units?
A. We will discuss this question and follow-up with an answer after the close date for questions.

Clarification: The City does not know where two and three wire units are located throughout the city. Please provide a cost to convert any units that may be found throughout the system and what your approach would be to supply the necessary equipment to upgrade any units that need replaced and/or converted.

New Questions:

- Q. I don't see in any of the instructional information, any information about a Bid Bond nor do I see any bid bond forms.
A. At this time the City is not going to require a Bid Bond. No bid bond forms are required at this time. Please disregard the information on Bid Bonding in Addendum 1.

- Q. Can you please let us know if a bid bond will be required and if so, are there any forms we access for this purpose?
A. At this time the City is not going to require a Bid Bond No bid bond forms are required at this time. Please disregard the information on Bid Bonding in Addendum 1.

Bonding Requirements

- a. The City of Elko may require a performance bond, payment bond or other bond (or a combination thereof), issued by a surety bonding company authorized to do business in Nevada.

(1) Any such bonds may be to insure proper performance of the contract and save, indemnify and keep harmless the City of Elko against all loss, damages, claims,



liabilities, judgments, costs and expenses which may accrue against the City of Elko in consequence of the awarding of the contract.

- (2) If the City of Elko requires such a bond, it shall not also require a detailed financial statement from the bidder.
- b. Bidders are hereby notified that, pursuant to 2 CFR § 200.326, for construction or facility improvement contracts or subcontracts exceeding the Simplified Acquisition Threshold, the Federal awarding agency or pass-through entity may accept the bonding policy and requirements of the non-Federal entity provided that the Federal awarding agency or pass-through entity has made a determination that the Federal interest is adequately protected. If such a determination has not been made, the minimum requirements must be as follows:
- (1) A bid guarantee from each bidder equivalent to five percent of the bid price. The “bid guarantee” must consist of a firm commitment such as a bid bond, certified check, or other negotiable instrument accompanying a bid as assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute such contractual documents as may be required within the time specified.
 - (2) A performance bond on the part of the contractor for 100 percent of the contract price. A “performance bond” is one executed in connection with a contract to secure fulfillment of all the contractor's requirements under such contract.
 - (3) A payment bond on the part of the contractor for 100 percent of the contract price. A “payment bond” is one executed in connection with a contract to assure payment as required by law of all persons supplying labor and material in the execution of the work provided for in the contract.

Q. I am assuming that the Database is phase one?

A. The city is looking for meters for all three phases. A total of 9,054 meters.

- Metered connections (Phase 1)
 - Residential = 1,161
 - Commercial = 376
- Unmetered connections with existing pits (Phase 2)
 - Residential = 2,804 (2,000 meters @ 3/4" connection; 804 @ 1" connection)
 - Commercial = 160 (75 meters @ 1.5"; 60 meters @ 2"; 15 meters @ 3"; 5 meters @ 4"; 5 meters @ 6")
- Unmetered connections with no pits (Phase 3)
 - Residential = 4,206 (3,000 meters @ 3/4" connection; 1,206 @ 1" connection)
 - Commercial = 347 (177 meters @ 1.5"; 120 meters @ 2"; 30 meters @ 3"; 10 meters @ 4"; 10 meters @ 6")

Q. Or is it phase one and phase 2?

A. All three phases.



Q. What are the current existing meter sizes that may need retro fitted?

A. 3/4" - 417 meters, 1" - 776 meters, 1.5" - 78 meters, 2" - 85 meters, 3" - 16 meters, 4"- meters, and 6"- 2 meters.

Total meter count 1,383.

Q. There for in the example below I would subtract phase 2 totals from whole number?

i.e. 4801 Total - 2000 phase 2 would equal a phase 1 of 2801? And 2000 in phase 2 for 5/8x3/4" meters (as I heard on the call that all 3/4" where a 5/8x3/4".
