

IMPORTANT ELECTION DATES

September 9, 2022	Deadline to Opt-Out for Mail Ballots (AB 321 2021 Legislative Session)
September 29, 2022	Mail Ballots will be mailed out
October 11, 2022	Deadline to register to vote in-person, by mail-in application or an outside agency. After this date, any registrations or updates must be done through NVSOS website at www.registertovote.nv.gov or in-person at Early Voting or Election Day.
October 11-25, 2022	Online registration and updates only at www.registertovote.nv.gov New registrants and voter updates will get a ballot in the mail.
October 22-November 4, 2022	Early Voting begins Elko County Convention Center 700 Moren Way, Elko, NV 89801 Saturdays: 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Monday - Friday: 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. <i>In-Person Same-Day Registration (SDR) available at EV. Must have a valid Nevada ID or Nevada DL. Proof of residency is required if the address on ID does not match.</i>
October 25, 2022	Last day to request a Mail Ballot.
October 26-November 8, 2022	Voters registering or making changes on the NVSOS website during this time are considered Online Same-Day Registrant (SDR). SDRs will not receive a ballot in the mail and must appear at a polling place to vote in-person with proper ID.
November 8, 2022	General Election Day (ED) Polls open at 7:00 a.m. Polls close at 7:00 p.m. *Mail Ballots returned via USPS must be postmarked by ED. *In person mail ballots must be received by the Clerk's Office or delivered to a polling location by 7:00 p.m. on ED.
November 12, 2022	Ballots mailed via USPS must be post marked by ED and received by the 4th day after ED.
November 14, 2022	Deadline to cure signature issues by 5:00 p.m.
