Polling Place Changes

The Board recently amended the Village's ward map upon completion of the 2020 Census. As part of this process staff proposed a reduction in the number of polling places in order to provide cost savings to the Village and make the election process more efficient. All registered voters will be receiving a mailing from the Village providing information on their polling place for the 2022 elections. The Village will now have 2 polling places - Greendale High School and Highland View Elementary. All residents who live east of Loomis Road will vote at Highland View and all residents that live west of Loomis Rd will vote at the High School. Until more vaccine is available, the state of Wisconsin is following prioritization guidelines from the federal Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the State Disaster Medical Advisory Committee (SDMAC). **The Greendale Health Department follows the guidelines given by the state of Wisconsin.** We cannot speak to the actions of other agencies.

The Greendale Health Department is committed to the equitable and fair distribution of the vaccine and is following prioritization guidelines.

According to the State of Wisconsin recommendations as of 2/2021

"Although all of the above (sic) groups will become eligible on March 1, vaccine providers should continue all efforts to reach the previously eligible groups. With a continued limited supply of vaccine, it will take many weeks to finish vaccinating previously eligible groups, particularly people age 65 and older. Providers should make every effort to vaccinate people over 65 (and other previously eligible groups) before starting to vaccinate the new group. When vaccinators are ready to begin vaccinating the newly eligible groups, vaccine providers are encouraged to prioritize within the newly eligible groups."
