



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

September 5, 2019

Project Description

The Village's contractor, G&M Cement will pave the prepared sections of **S Bruner St, E 7th St, and S Oak St** on **Friday, September 6th**. **Please note that this activity will affect your driveway access and ALL street parking will be prohibited.** Residents are encouraged to use alternate parking locations (Monday through Friday) for daily and overnight parking.

Friday, September 6th: Contractor will pave the prepared half the street. The new concrete will need 4-5 days to cure and gain strength before we can restore access for affected driveways

Project Locations (in street order)

- S Bruner (8th St to 7th St)
- E 7th St (Oak St to County Line Rd)
- S Oak St (7th St to 8th St)

Impacts to Residents

The scheduled activities will take place from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. During the project activities, street parking will be prohibited. Residents are encouraged to relocate their vehicles to alternate side streets to avoid conflicts with these activities. Please maintain a 30 foot clearance from all intersections. The Police Department has been notified of this alternate parking arrangement for daily and overnight periods. Maintain your garbage and recycling routines. Once the concrete has cured and gained strength, temporary driveway access will be restored to completed sides of the street (from 5PM to 7AM).

In order to control cracking of fresh concrete, the contractor is required to saw cut the new pavement the same day as the pour. This operation will extend into the evening hours (estimated completion time of 12:30 AM). This activity may resume on Saturday morning to complete all sawing.

Alternate Parking Locations

- S Bruner St (use 8th St or 7th St or S Bruner, south of 8th St)
- E 7th St (use Oak St, north of 7th St)
- S Oak St (use 7th or 8th St)
