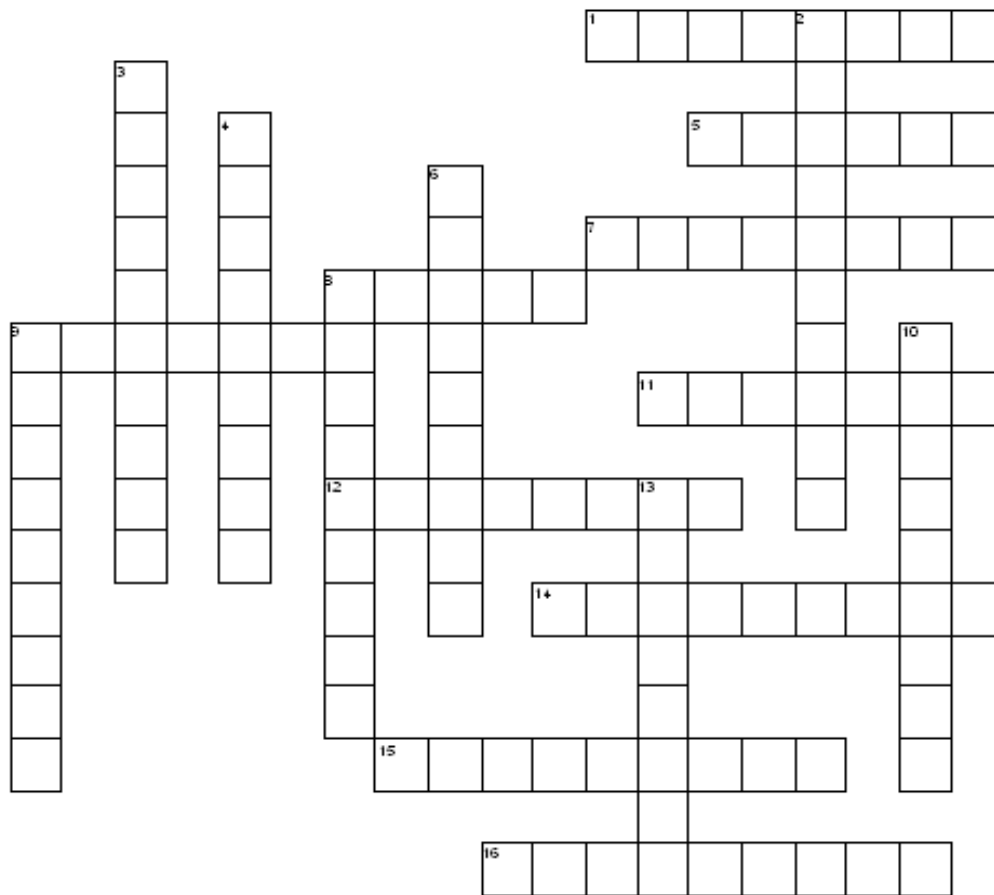

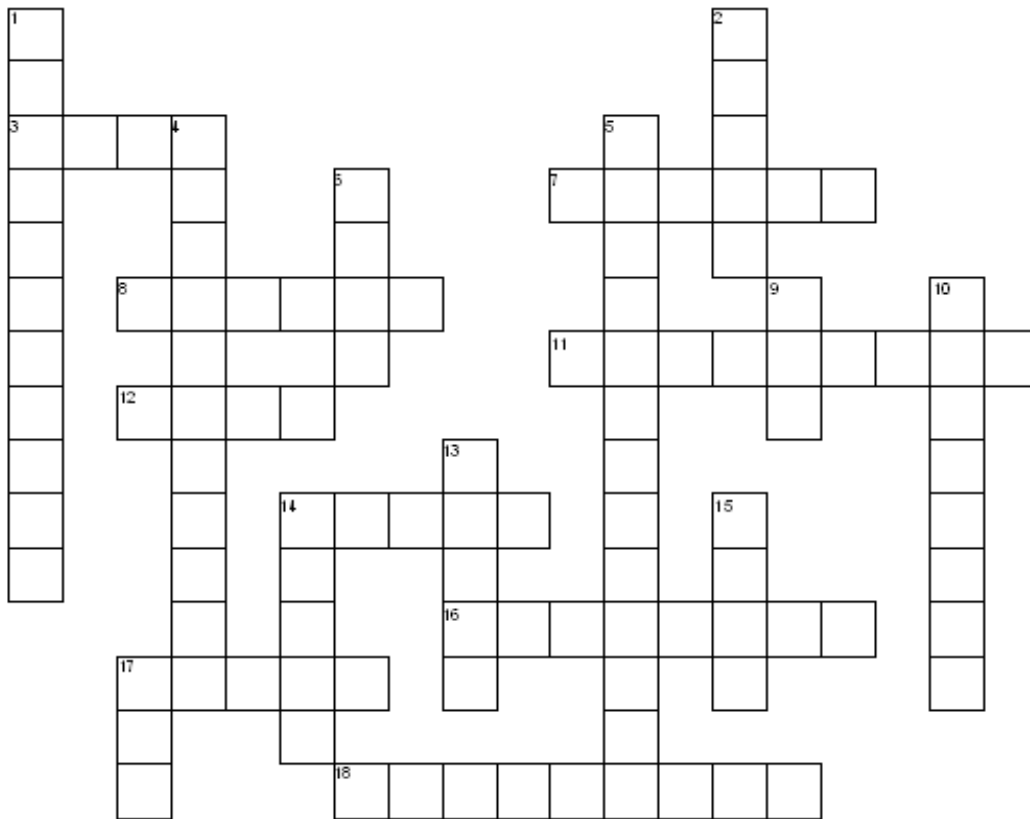
- 2 You wear these instead of shoes when you visit an ice rink. They rhyme with "plates."

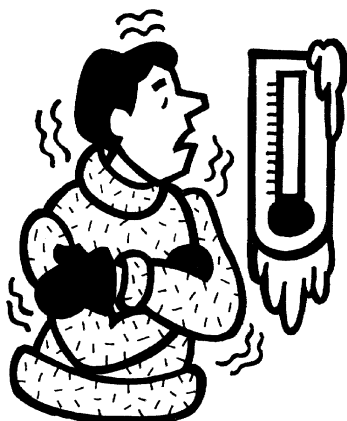

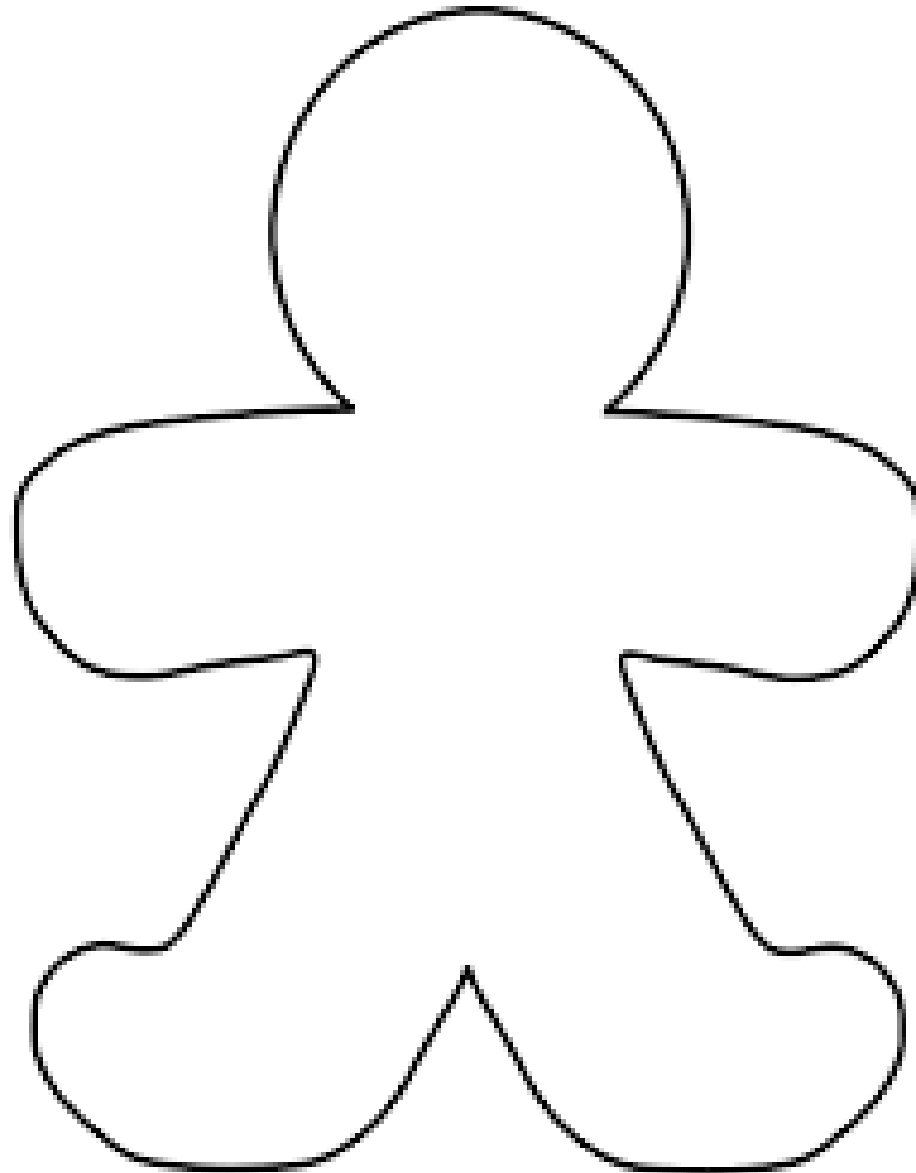
